## 2017 Mark Skutle Memorial Mid-Range Championship

Dates: October 14-15, 2017

**Location**: River Bend Gun Club, Dawson Co., GA. River Bend Gun Club is located north of Atlanta in the southeast corner of Dawson County, approximately one hour drive from Atlanta. From the north side of I-285 take GA 400 to intersection of State 369. Go 12.3 miles to Yellow Creek Road. Turn right and go 4.5 miles to Shiloh Church Road. Turn right and go 0.3 miles to paved fork; bear right to gravel county road to the gun club—1.25 miles.

**Times**: Registration from 7:30 to 8:30. Firing begins at 9:00 am.

Eligibility: Open.

**Registration & Fees**: Advanced registration not required, but will reserve you a place. Limited to 72 competitors (with 3 relays). Post entries accepted to capacity of the range. Fees for the registered match: \$25.00 single day, \$40 both days – includes NRA registration fee. Fee for Juniors is \$10/day (<21).

Classification & Awards: NRA Mid Range classification system will be used with a minimum of 5 entries needed to establish a class. Unclassified shooter will complete in the master class. Appropriate NRA points or cash will be given to the match winner and all class winners—first place for 5 or more entrants in a class, second for 8 or more and third for 11 or more in the class. Awards will also be paid to the two-day high aggregate for both sling shooters and F-class. Special category award for top Palma rifle 2 day score.

Rules: Current NRA High Power and NRA F-Class rules will govern throughout.

**Pit Service & Scoring:** Competitors will be required to operate pits and score for other competitors.

**Scorecards:** It is the competitor responsibility to fill out the score card completely. If a score card is turned in without the rifle type indicated for a Match the shooter will be **disqualified** and the score will be recorded in the Any/Any category. No awards will be paid to disqualified shooters.

**Rifles & Ammunition**: Any Rifle (Rule 3.2), Service Rifle (Rule 3.1) or F-Class (Rule 3.4 F-class) Rule 9.1 (Changing Rifles) does not apply, however if a competitor changes divisions they will not be eligible for Match 7 awards. Competitors will furnish their own ammunition (Rule 3.17)

**Safety**: Use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) in each rifle is required at all times when it is not on the line during the 25 min. block times. At the match director's discretion, a competitor will be asked to cease fire if their bullet impacts are not on paper within 7 shots.

**Course of Fire**: Competitors may shoot in only one Division per Match.

**Targets:** MR-1 for conventional rifles, MR-1FC for F-Class for Matches 1-6.
