

2018 River Bend Gun Club NRA Highpower Mid-Range 600 x 3 Match Program

Dates: March 11 (Club Match), April 29 (NRA), June 10 (NRA), July 15 (NRA), Aug. 12 (NRA), Sept. 16 (NRA), Nov. 11 (NRA), Dec. 2 (Club match) OCT 13/14 will be the 600x6, see 2018 Mark Skutle Match program for details

Location: River Bend Gun Club, Dawsonville, GA. From the north side of I-285 take GA 400 to intersection of State 369. Go 12.3 miles to Yellow Creek Road. Turn right and go 4.5 miles to Shiloh Church Road. Turn right and go 0.3 miles to paved fork; bear right to gravel county road to the gun club—1.25 miles

Rules: Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules Apply

Eligibility: Open. NRA membership is encouraged, but not required.

Classification: NRA Mid Range classification system will be used. Unclassified shooter will complete in the master class. Classes with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class.

Fees: NRA Approved: \$20 RBGC members, \$25 non-members, \$10 Juniors (<21)
Club Match: \$15 RBGC members, \$20 non-members, \$10 Juniors

Rifles Permitted: NRA Rules 3.1 (Service Rifle), 3.2 (Any Rifle), 3.3 (NRA Match/Palma Rifle), 3.3.3 (Tactical AR), or 3.4 (F-class) in Matches 1-4. Rule 9.1 (Changing Rifles) does not apply, however if a competitor changes divisions they will not be eligible for Match 4 awards.

Divisions:

1. Service Rifle (Any Sight)
2. Any/Irons and Palma
3. Any Rifle/Any Sight
4. Tactical AR
5. F-TR
6. F-Open

Ammunition: NRA Rule 3.17, furnished by the competitor

Targets: MR-1 (or MR-1FC) will be used at 600 yds

Squadding: Squadding will be done during registration just prior to the match, we use a 3 relay rotation.

Scoring and Pit duty: All competitors will be required to score and pull targets for other relays.

Challenges: A fee of \$1 will be charged in advance for each challenge

Match Schedule: Registration: 8:00 to 8:30. First shot downrange at 9:00 am.

Match 1: 600 yards, Slow Fire, Prone, Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots, 25 min. block time

Match 2: 600 yards, Slow Fire, Prone, Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots, 25 min. block time

Match 3: 600 yards, Slow Fire, Prone, Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots, 25 min. block time

Match 4: Aggregate of Matches 1-3

Awards: Place awards for Match 1- 4 winners in each division. Additional awards by classification in each division. A minimum of 5 shooters is needed to establish a class.
