Describe your personal participation in shooting activities at RBGC:

The River Bend Gun Club awards scholarships to the sons, daughters and legal wards of RBGC members in good standing who have been members for two years or more at the time the scholarship application is submitted. The official membership date is the date the member's membership application was accepted by the RBGC Board. The award is \$1,000 per year for four years, provided that (a) the parent maintains RBGC membership and (b) for each of the second, third, and fourth academic years the Scholarship recipient demonstrates that he or she is a full time student at an accredited college or professional school with a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher.

The Cumulative Grade Point Average is the grade point average for all previous academic years. For example, the Cumulative Grade Point Average for the first and second academic years will be used to determine whether the Scholarship recipient continues to be eligible for the Scholarship for the third academic year. When and if a Scholarship recipient's Cumulative Grade Point Average drops below 3.0, the \$1,000 annual award for the next academic year is eliminated. If the Scholarship recipient raises his or her Cumulative Grade Point Average to 3.0 or above the annual award is reactivated for the academic years remaining within the original four-year award period. For example, if a Scholarship recipient failed to qualify for an award for the 2018/2019 academic year, he or she could still qualify for and receive an annual award for the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 academic years. However, Scholarship recipients who report two or more years with Cumulative Grade Point Averages below 3.0 are dropped from the program and are not eligible for reinstatement. The Cumulative Grade Point Average is not rounded up to 3.0, but is used exactly as reported by the institution.

The annual scholarship awards are made or eliminated for entire academic years and not portions of academic years. An "academic year" is the year starting at the beginning of the fall semester and ending at the end of the summer semester.

The Scholarship recipient is eligible for an award for four academic years starting with the year the award is granted. For example, the 2017 award will be in effect for the academic years 2017/2018 thru 2020/2021, provided that the criteria described above are met. Year 2, 3 and 4 scholars are required to provide their transcripts during July or August for the previous academic year and proof of enrollment for the coming year. Year 1 scholars are required to provide proof of enrollment for the coming year.

All students entering accredited undergraduate or graduate college/professional-technical schools may apply. All 2017 applications must be e-mail dated or post marked by December 31, 2016.

This application is to be completed and submitted by the scholarship applicant. Attach a one-page handwritten essay outlining the applicant's academic and career goals. Explain how this scholarship will help achieve those goals. (Use black ink; white lined college ruled paper may be used).

Include two letters of reference; one from a schoolteacher, instructor or professor and one from a person outside the field of education.

Place all materials in a 9 X 12 envelope and mail. The criteria used to evaluate applications include assessing the applicant's ability to interpret and follow application instructions and submit a complete, accurate and professional application.

Applications may be submitted by e-mail. Scan all documents and attachments, save as a PDF file and attached to the e-mail.
